Join the fun this summer at The Clay Studio for weeklong clay camps for ages 6 to 17! Campers expand their imaginations and explore the exciting world of clay and more. Whether working with sculpture, clay animation, or wheel-thrown pottery, students learn in a supportive and small class setting with plenty of individual instruction and inspiration from our professional teaching artists. On select weeks this summer we are partnering with Kaya Aerial Yoga, Mind Over Matter Yoga, and the Philadelphia Dance Academy in Old City to offer movement-based camps in addition to our clay camps. Every Friday parents and campers celebrate with an exhibition of works in progress, performances, and an ice cream party! Each camper receives a free camp T-shirt. Lunch includes weekly visits to Cherry Street Pier, local galleries, and historic sites.

FEES AND HOURS

Half-day camps: \$180 (Dual/Family Members \$160)
Half-day camps meet for three hours and include a short snack break.
Full-day Claymation camps: \$360 (Dual/Family Members \$320)
Full-day Claymation camps meet from 9 am - 4 pm and include a one-hour supervised lunch.

Parents provide snacks and lunches.

Extended Care is available from 4:00-6:00pm for \$50 per week.

Supervised lunch is available for half-day campers for \$20 per week. Lunch is free for campers staying for a full day.

Clay camps fill quickly — full tuition or a \$100 non-refundable deposit per camper is due upon registration. We accept cash, check and all major credit cards. If the minimum registration is not met, The Clay Studio reserves the right to cancel the program and either move participants to another camp or refund all payments.

The Clay Studio sends a confirmation and forms one week prior to the start of each camp.

REFUND POLICY

Cancellations processed at least one week (7 days) before camp begins receive a full refund less a \$15 processing fee. Tuition credit is given for cancellations less than one week (7 days) before the first day of the scheduled camp. The first switch from one camp to another does not incur a fee. No refunds or pro-rating for missed classes. Enrollment fees cannot be carried into subsequent terms. Membership fees are non-refundable.

WEEK 1 • June 24 - 28

Wheel Throwing 101 ages 9 to 12

9 am - 12 pm

19-CC01 Make fun, functional forms on the potter's wheel. Learn to create bowls, cups, and vases and explore different decorating techniques to add personalized style to your work.

Clay Story ages 9 to 12

1 pm - 4 pm

19-CCO2 Explore the different forms you can make with handbuilding techniques and continue to build your skills throwing on the wheel as you discover the unique ways you can tell stories in clay. Examine how storytelling on ceramics has been used throughout history and draw inspiration from contemporary artists and your favorite books and comics in this engaging camp.

WEEK 2 • July 8 - 12

Claymation: Full Day Camp

9 am - 4 pm [19-cco3: ages 6 to 8 | 19-cco4: ages 9 to 12]

Ever wondered how movies like *Shaun the Sheep, Frankenweenie,* or *The Nightmare Before Christmas* were made? Learn how to create, storyboard, and animate both cutout and clay characters using the art of stop-motion animation. You'll develop storylines, direct, and supply voices for characters. After editing, each camper is emailed a link to the YouTube videos of individual work and group projects. Ages 6-8 spend half the day making clay animations and half the day making clay projects inspired by their videos and stories.

Clay to Table ages 9 to 12
